Please accept our invitation for your child to join the Lakewood Challenger Sports League Team! The team competes in the POAC Challenger Sports League and is designed to offer students a socialization opportunity through athletic participation. Students are eligible to participate on the challenger team when they are in seventh grade. Students with special needs can participate until the age 21. All uniforms are provided at no cost as well as transportation for each game. Parents are welcome to attend games, however it is not required.

This league is the first of its kind in our area - a middle and high school level challenger league which has been embraced by many schools in Ocean and Monmouth counties. It enables students with special needs who would not ordinarily participate in typical middle school and high school sports, to now have the opportunity to play in a competitive sports league.

This league is co-ed and plays flag football and soccer in the fall, basketball in the winter, and baseball in the spring. We will also encourage students who are enrolled in middle school and high school sports to volunteer as buddies. This creates an opportunity for our students to interact with their fellow athletic peers.
