As done in previous years, there will be Seven (7) satellite sites in addition to the Resident Drop Off Center (The Hill) for the annual Spring Cleaning Event. The locations and hours will be:

1 - The Resident Drop Off : Opens Monday April 3rd 7:30am. Closes Wednesday April 5th 3:00pm. = 56 hours

2 - 9th & Clifton. Opens Monday April 3rd 12:00pm. Closes. Wednesday April 5th 12:00pm = 48 hours

3 - 9th & Forest Ave. Opens Monday April 3rd 12:00pm. Closes. Wednesday April 5th 12:00pm = 48 hours

4 - Brook Road Park. Opens Monday April 3rd 12:00pm. Closes. Wednesday April 5th 12:00pm = 48 hours

5 - Sunset Road Park. Opens Monday April 3rd 12:00pm. Closes. Wednesday April 5th 12:00pm = 48 hours

6 - West Gate on Hillside Blvd. Opens Monday April 3rd 12:00pm. Closes. Wednesday April 5th 12:00pm

= 48 hours

7 - Patrick Park. Located off of Vine Ave Opens Monday April 3rd 12:00pm. Closes. Wednesday April 5th

12:00pm = 48 hours

8 - D'Zio Park Located off of Locust Street Opens Monday April 3rd 12:00pm. Closes. Wednesday April 5th 12:00pm = 48 hours

The hours of operation for all the satellite sites are: Monday April 3rd at 12:00pm and will remain open until 12pm Wednesday April 5th.

Here is a list of what you can bring to the resident drop off and satellite sites: Couches, chairs, sofas, doors, tables, all household furniture All household electronics and E-Waste. All metal, refrigerators, grills, and other household appliances. We have special containers for clothes and shredded paper.

Prohibited items that the Resident drop off and the satellite sites cannot accept are: Tires, pallets, batteries, home renovations or DIY projects. Wood, paint, household chemicals, commercial construction and/or demolition material, large amounts of wood, cabinets, drywall, sheetrock, plaster and concrete.

Please do not put bulk trash out unless you have a scheduled appointment.

All materials brought to and/or picked up by Lakewood Township Public Works can be denied at the discretion of its management.
